We can now send other health information out by SMS such as letting you know that your results are back, or that we need to get in touch with you. We might also occasionally send information about special clinics we are running that you might be interested in.




The SMS service should not be solely relied upon, as the responsibility of attending and cancelling appointments still rests with you, but we hope this will make things easier.
